

UPCOMING STOCK ASSESSMENT 21/22

STOCK ASSESSMENT (MRAG UK)

- Involving fisherfolks themselves (divers, skippers & vessel owners)
- To be accompanied by m/v Amitie independently (SFA Research team)
- x2 trips –November 21 & February 22 (End of season data assessment ready)
- Quota for 22/23 will be based on => SA and actual harvested & landed
- Options:
 - (i) Hire a complete vessel / pay for full trip / all species (not only the x3)*
 - (ii) Pay individual divers & team members on x1 vessel





Stakeholder's Session

BEST MANAGED FISHERY IN SEYCHELLES

- Catch Data documentation & accuracy important to maintain
- MAC clear on their role as advisory
- **♦** SFA to be the regulator & quota distributor
- If any force majeure it has to be reported to SFA
- No longer boat-to-boat quota distribution
- No IUU fishing / exchanges at sea
- Respect to licensing conditions (VMS, crew composition, etc.)
